COVID: SOCIAL DISTANCING

A huge thank you to the parents for using the one-way system that we have had to implement. The doors will continue to remain open between 8.40am-8.55am to allow for a continuous flow of children into the school. Children can arrive anytime during this 15 minute 'window' to allow for social distancing between parents and carers on the playground.

We would like to remind you that, were possible, only ONE parent or carer should be dropping off or collecting from the school site as the fewer the parents/carers we have on the school site, the easier it is to social distance.

Please do not block the exit gate by talking to other parents or encouraging your child to leave the site. Collection of your child/ren can occur between 2.50pm and 3.10pm, again this is to allow you to successfully social distance.
